

Camping

You must camp only in those places specifically provided.

- All vehicles, RVs, and trailers must be parked at your campsite. Driving or parking off road is not permitted.
- Camping longer than 14 consecutive days is generally not allowed.
- Tent camping, west of the RV sites, is \$5.00 per night. RV sites are \$15.00 per night. Camping sites are first come first served. No reservations will be taken for the campsites.
- Pitch your tent directly on the ground. Please do not dig trenches in the ground or place pegs in rock surface.

Lanterns

Hanging gas or propane lanterns on trees can kill or seriously damage them. Help us preserve the park by hanging lanterns in a safe place away from the trees.

Firearms/Fireworks

For your safety and the safety of others, firearms, ammunition and fireworks may not be brought into or used in any park area. Hunting is not permitted.

Camp Fires

- Obey any restrictions on fires. Fires may be limited or prohibited at certain times.
- Within campgrounds and other recreation areas, fires may only be built in fire rings or grills provided for that purpose.
- Be sure your fire is completely extinguished before leaving. Do not leave your fire unattended. You are responsible for keeping fires under control.

Noise

Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 6 am every night. Excessively loud vehicles or motorized equipment are prohibited in the parks. In consideration of all park users, we ask that volumes be kept low when using radios, televisions or similar devices.

Pets and animals

Pets must be on a leash less than six feet in length or physically restrained in some other manner. This will help protect your pet from other animals. Livestock is prohibited in all recreation areas.

Sanitation

- Help prevent pollution by keeping garbage, litter, and foreign substances out of the lake.
- All garbage and litter must either be deposited in containers provided, or taken with you when you leave.
- There is no dump station on site so please no dumping of black or gray water.

Vehicle Operation

- Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only.
- Use of vehicles within campgrounds and other recreation areas is limited to entering or leaving those areas.

Public Property

- Preserve and protect the lake areas. Leave natural areas the way you find them.
- Do not carve, chop, cut and damage any live trees.

Special Events

Large activities not normally provided for with available recreation amenities, or those that will impact visitation to the lake, require permission and reservation. These may be scheduled in advance at the Gridley City Hall, 503 Main or by calling 620-836-3145. The covered shelter rents for \$25.00 a day.

The permittee is responsible for taking all necessary precautions to provide for the health and safety requirements of the participants and spectators.

The permittee will clean the grounds, remove equipment, and restore the permitted site.

The permittee will not nail, staple, or otherwise attach any event-connected signs or decorations to any part of the covered shelter, signpost, bathroom, utility pole, covered picnic tables, or trees.

Fishing

There is free fishing to anglers holding a Kansas State Fishing License. All anglers must adhere to the posted minimum and slot length limits and creel limits.
